INAYATIYYA TEACHINGS

Hazrat Inayat Khan

Bowl of Saki, June 29 - Commentary:

The worlds are held together by the heat of the sun; each of us are atoms held in position by that eternal Sun we call God. Within us is the same central power we call the light, or the love of God; by it we hold together the human beings within our sphere, or, lacking it, we let them fall.

Vol VIIIa: Sufi Teachings—Section II: Chapter 13 Manifestation and Perfection

A close study of the formation of the sun and of its influence on everything in life will help us to understand the divine Spirit. Heat, gas-light, electric light, the coal fire, the wood fire, the candle, the flame of the oil-lamp, all these different manifestations of light have their source in the sun; it is the sun which is showing itself in all these different forms, although we generally consider the sun to be separate from all other aspects of light. In the same way the supreme Spirit is manifested in all forms, in all things and beings, in the seen and unseen worlds; and yet it stands remote, as the sun stands remote from all other forms of light. The Qur'an says, 'God is the light of heaven and of earth'; and in reality, all forms, however dense they may be, are to some degree the radiance of that spirit which is all light. All the different colors are different degrees of that same light.

Vol I: The Way of Illumination – Section IV: The Purpose of Life – Chapter 12

The Sufis say, 'God is Love'. That is true, but the Love was not sufficient. The Love had to make an object to love in order to see its own nature, to experience its own character, to fathom its own mystery, to find its own joy. For instance, the seed has in it the leaf and the flower and the fruit; but the fulfillment of the purpose of that seed is that it is put in the ground, that it is watered, that a seedling springs up and is reared by the sun; it brings forth its flowers and fruits.

This is the fulfillment of that seed which already contained in itself, the fruit and flower. A person who does not see the reason of all this, is in the seed state; his mind is in the state of a seed which has not yet germinated, which has not yet produced its seedling, which has not yet experienced the springing of the plant.

No sooner does the soul begin to unfold and experience in life the purpose which is hidden within itself, than it begins to feel the joy of it; it begins to value the privilege of living; it begins to appreciate everything; it begins to marvel at everything. For in every experience, good or bad, it finds a certain joy, and that joy is in the fulfillment of life's purpose.

That joy is not only experienced in pleasure but even in pain, not only in success but also in failures; not only in the cheerfulness of the heart but even in the breaking of the heart there is a certain joy hidden. For there is no experience which is worthless; and specially for that soul who is beginning to realize this purpose, there is no moment wasted in life. For under all circumstances and in all experiences that soul is experiencing the purpose of life.

Nature Meditation - FIKR

Memorize each phrase by saying it aloud (5 times), then repeat each phrase silently as you exhale and inhale (11 times). Continue breathing in a natural rhythm, without the words and notice what arises.

Exhale: Fire, in thee I see

Inhale: The maker, purifier and healer: God

Fikr is the practice of reciting a word or phrase silently on the breath as one inhales and exhales. Its purpose is the use of breath as a form of spiritual practice, enabling the words or phrases to penetrate into one's very being. [Preface to 2005 Edition]

7th **Generation is a practice of imagination and deep listening** and was conducted in breakout rooms with 4 people. The instructions and questions are included on the recording along with feedback from participants at the end of the session.

You may like to try this on your own as a writing exercise – or a small group (2-4) people.

You are invited to imagine having a conversation with future humans from seven generations ahead, about 200 years from now, so it would be in the year 2223/2224. If you are in a group, assign one person as the future being and the others speak for approx. 3 mins each for each of the three questions. If you are doing this on our own – you could take a short break after the third question, then review what you have written and respond as the descendent from the future. The questions are written here in the Newsletter and there is also a link to an audio recording of the question, if you prefer to listen.

A couple of assumptions are needed before you begin:

- o that there are people living on Earth in 200 years from now, living in some sort of life sustaining communities.
- o that the future ones have a cultural memory of what is happening today, carried by universities or by books or by storytellers or by songs.

As we all know, our society, as we are living today is unlikely to last another 200 years – so we need to accept that there has been some significant "change event" or series of events. We do not need to know what that was.

In order to meet across the two centuries, we must go to a point outside of time, so we will travel there by the power of our intention and imagination - with a long "ah" sound.

Your descendent (approx. 200 years) in the future speaks:

Question 1: Audio Link

Ancestor, I greet you. It's so amazing to see your face, because all my life I have heard stories from teachers and grandparents about the time you are living. Some of the things I've heard I find hard to believe, so I'd like to check them out with you.

They say that in your time there are a few people richer than the richest ancient kings, while billions of people are without enough food or shelter or clean water. They tell us that in your time bombs are being made that can blow up whole cities. We know about that, but they say you know about it too, right when the bombs are being made. They tell us that whole species of animals and plants are going extinct. We know about that, too, because gone is gone.

But they tell us you know about that while it's happening. Is that true? And if it is true, what's that like for you?

Question 2: Audio Link

Ancestor, I greet you. When we in our generation find water, we can drink and soil that's safe to grow food, it is thanks to the work you and your friends are doing on our behalf. It must be hard for you, especially at the beginning, standing up for beings you haven't met and will never meet. So, I want to ask you this question: What inspired you to start on this path? And what were the first steps you took?

Question 3: Audio Link

Ancestor, I greet you. We know you did not stop with those first steps. There are stories and songs about what you and your friends are doing to leave us a livable world. What they don't tell us, and what I would really like to know, is where you find the strength to do this. Where do you find the power to keep on going for the sake of life, despite all the obstacles and discouragements? Can you tell me?

Now, you of the seventh generation, it is your turn to talk. Audio Link

You have been listening to your ancestors speak of their experience. As you listened, thoughts and feelings arose in you. Now is your chance to express them. What is in your heart to say to the one before you? Very soon this person will be returning right into the midst of that darkness and travail. What words do you have for him or her?

EARTH RESPONDERS PILOT 2023

This last year, between June and December, several Ziraat Council members took part in a special pilot program coordinated by Rabia Povich, Inayatiyya Kinship leader. It was a trial of a new course for Murids and Ashiqs wishing to connect and serve Earth during our time of climate change and social upheaval. The trial involved a group of 10 people who received guidance and practices for each stage of the Kinship Activity: Respect, Sympathy, Understanding, Forgiveness (of self and other), and Unity.

The inaugural <u>Earth Responders</u> program is open to the public and will run from April 3 to May 15. (see details on page 10). Saraswati Burke and Zebunissa Overeynder were part of the pilot group and have written about their experiences.

We Are Earth: Empowering ... Blessing ... Connection – Saraswati Burke

This included: support to human or other-than human communities as the multitude of needs is growing; increased awareness of our inter-connection to the whole web of life; deepening our connection; and learning from nature-based wisdom traditions. These were just a few of the threads knotted into the hearts and minds of the participants.

We shared emotional experiences (wonder, shock, grief), music, ritual, art, connections to Indigenous wisdom, and practical actions. Sham's Kairys frequently gave the Earth Responders sage guidance and clarity reminding all to:

See from another's point of view
Deepen our understanding of the natural world
Hold and process grief
Hold grief and hope together
Find forgiveness (deepen tolerance) and
Facilitate heart-centeredness

And, to not overlook certain practical capacities Earth Responders will need to know how to:make known your availability

...describe what you have to offer

...identify the/a key contact person

...learn what is wanted/needed in a particular situation

And ...how to enter a complex, likely disordered situation and get your bearings



Earth Responders Pilot 2023: A Wonderful Opportunity - Zebunissa Overeynder

What a wonderful opportunity to commit to serving the unity of life in whatever ways we are inspired to do. Though the Kinship activity leads the effort, it is a collaboration with all of the Inayatiyya activities involved. Kinship became a very alive reality on so many levels—from the kinship of our small group to kinship with the Earth and all beings, human and more than human. I came away with such a deep attunement and respect for all life. We were a small and very dedicated group and we bonded deeply.

I can say that this experience was affirming and even life-changing for me. The material presented was inspiring, sometimes challenging, and always led to a life-affirming perspective. I had been longing for a small group of friends who shared my concern for the earth crisis to commune with and our small group met that need. In this safe and loving container, I was able to begin to befriend the well of grief I had been carefully controlling so as not to be completely overwhelmed. I found new reservoirs of hope and, despite the desperate situation, I could feel my capacity for resilience grow stronger.
